 5th December 1983.—Whereas 1255 hectare
 (0.31 of an acre), more or less, of land situated in or
 near the village of Dwarka, described below, has been
 requisitioned under sub-section (1) of section 3 of
 the West Bengal Land (Requisition and Acquisition)
 Act, 1948, by the person authorised under section 3
 (1A) of the Act for the public purpose of providing
 facilities for irrigation and drainage, namely, for
 extending water course off taking from ch. 1060 (L.B.)
 of M.B.B.C.;

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given that in pur-
 suance of section 4 of the said Act, the Governor
 acquires such land being required for a public purpose as
 aforesaid.

This case was started on receipt of a proposal from the Ex. C. ~~M. B. A. S. D. B. M.~~ ^{Ex. C. D. B. M.} Mr. H. H. D. B. M. with his Memo No. 8276 dt. 27-9-79 for acquisition of 31 acre of land for the purpose of extending water course off-taking from ch. 1060 (L.B.) of M.B.A.C. ^{No. 126} for Mysa Dwarka ^{Ex. C. D. B. M.} Talpur, Dist-Birbhum. The said area was requisitioned u/s 36 of the L.A. Act 1948 by order of collector dt. 11-9-80. There after the possession of the said area was taken over and made over to the R.B. on 15-1-81. The notice u/s 4 (a) bearing no 8441 L.A.-P.W. dt. 5-12-83 covering an entire area 7.31 acre has been sent to the press for publication in an extraordinary issue of the Calcutta Gazette on 13.12.83.

7 (Sen) sales are available in respect of the above class of land. The average rate of these sales comes to Rs 108788/- - Rs. 15541-14 or say Rs 15540/- per acre.

Classification - Pukurpar

No sale is available of the above class of land. The Pukurpar land is to be converted to the cultivated land, the owner shall have to spend 40% of the land value of the cultivated land over it. Hence the value of the Pukurpar land may be assessed at 40% less than the rate of Doam class of land i.e. Rs 9324/- or say Rs 9320/- per acre.

No sale is available in respect of the Pukur class of land. Only 0.4 acre area hukar land in sloping area are affected. Hence the value of the said area may be assessed at 30% of the value of the adjoining class cultivated land i.e. Rs 7770/- per acre.
