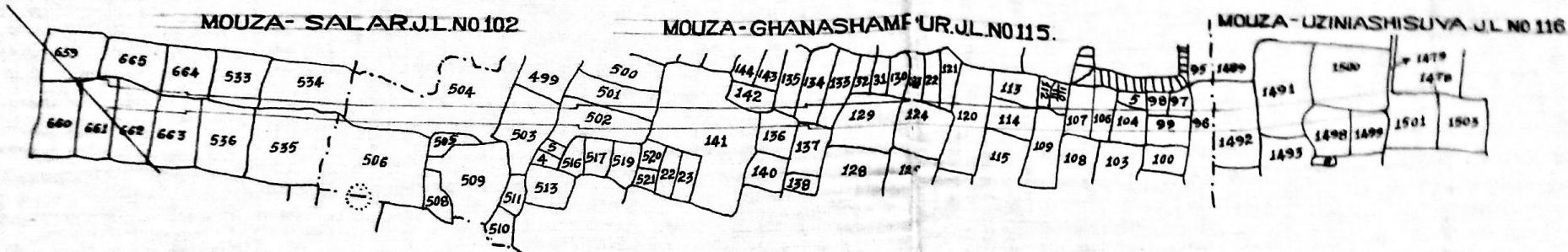


PLAN
