JALPAIGURI.—No. 4737LA(II)/1M-1/83.—
2nd July 1983.—Whereas the functions of the Central Government under the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (I of 1894), in relation to the acquisition of land for the purpose of the Union have been entrusted to the State Government by notification No. 20/1/55-Judl., dated the 14th May, 1955, issued by the Government of India in the Ministry of Home Affairs under clause (1) of article 258 of the Constitution of India as S.R.O. 1074, and published at page 868, Part II, section 3, of the "Gazette of India, dated 21st May 1955;

And whereas it appears to the Governor that the land is likely to be needed for a public purpose, namely, for construction of Military Air Port for Defence purpose in the village of Satali Mondalpara, P. S. Kalchini, district Jalpaiguri, it is hereby notified that pieces of land comprising R. S. plots as described in the schedule below and measuring, more or less, 119.38 hectares (2.95 acres) are likely to be needed for the aforesaid purpose at the public expense within the aforesaid village of Satali Mondalpara.

This notification is made under the provisions of section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (Act I of 1894), to all whom it may concern.

A plan of the land may be inspected in the office of the Deputy Commissioner, Jalpaiguri.

BIRBHUM.—No. 4762LA(II) 6P-1/83.—2nd July 1983.—Whereas the functions of the Central Government under the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (Act I of 1894) in relation to the acquisition of land for the purposes of the Union have been entrusted to the State Government by Notification No. 20/1/55 Judl.(1) dated the 19th May, 1955, issued by the Government of India in the Ministry of Home Affairs under clause (1) of article 258 of the Constitution of India as S.R.O. 1074 and published at page 868, Part II, section 3 of the "Gazette of India" dated 21st May 1955:

And whereas it appears to the Governor that land is likely to be needed for a public purpose, namely, for setting up Microwave Location at Suri in connection with improved communication system in the village of Abdarpur, jurisdiction list No. 97, police-station Suri, district Birbhum, it is hereby notified that a piece of land described in the schedule below and measuring, more or less, 1.4853 hectare (3.67 acres) is likely to be needed for the aforesaid public purpose at the public expense within the aforesaid village of Abdarpur in the district of Birbhum.
