Land Acquisition

NOTIFICATION

Birbhum.—No. 7890L.A.—22nd June 1962.—
Whereas it appears to the Governor that land is likely to be needed for a public purpose, not being a purpose of the Union, namely, for construction of a warehouse by the Central Warehousing Corporation, in the village of Sainthia, jurisdiction list No. 95, police-station Sainthia, district Birbhum, it is hereby notified that a piece of land comprising cadastral plot No. 2967/3084 and measuring, more or less, 2.68 acres, is likely to be needed for the aforesaid public purpose at the expense of the aforesaid Company within the aforesaid village of Sainthia.

This notification is made under the provisions of section 4 of Land Acquisition Act of 1894, to all whom it may concern.

A plan of the land may be inspected in the office of the Collector of Birbhum.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the aforesaid section the Governor is pleased to authorise the Officers for the time being engaged in the under-

taking, with their servants and workmen, to enter upon and survey the land and do all other acts required or permitted by that section.

Any person interested in the above land, who has any objection to the acquisition thereof, may, within thirty days after the date on which public notice of the substance of this notification is given in the locality, file an objection in writing before the Collector, Birbhum.
