

Birbhum.—No. 22442L.A.(P.W.).—3rd December, 1959.—Whereas 2.00 acres, more or less, of land situate in or near the village of Nalhati described below, have been requisitioned under sub-section (1) of section 3 of the West Bengal Land (Requisition and Acquisition) Act, 1948, by the person authorised under the said section 3 (1) for the purpose of providing facilities for transport and communication, namely, for construction of Mollarpur-Rampurhat-Nalhati State Highway;
