CALCUTTA.—No. 4990 L. A. (II)/5M-2/85.— 1st September 1988.—Whereas it appears to the Governor that land is likely to be needed for a public purpose, namely, for splaying off Corner of Northern Avenue at its junction with Sreenath Mukherjee Lane, it is hereby notified that a piece of land comprising of Premises No. 24C Northern Avenue, and measuring, more or less, 0.0009 of a hectare (0.0023 of an acre) and bounded on the—

is likely to be needed for the aforesaid public purpose at the expense of the Calcutta Municipal Corporation within the aforesaid Ward No. 4 of the Calcutta Municipal Corporation in the City of Calcutta.

This notification is made under the provisions of section 4 of Act I of 1894, to all whom it may concern.
