BIRBHUM.— No. 19664L.A./1R-14/64. — 30th November 1966.—Whereas the functions of the Central Government under the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (Act I of 1894), in relation to the acquisition of land for the purpose of the Union, have been entrusted to the State Government by notification No. 20/1/55 Judl. (1), dated the 14th May 1955, issued by the Government of India, in the Ministry of Home Affairs, under clause (1) of article 258 of the Constitution of India, as S.R.O. 1074 and published at page 868, Part II, Section 3, of "Gazette of India," dated the 21st May 1955;

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that needed for a public purpose, namely, for the truction of double line on the Sahibgani Loop (Loop Line) between Sainthia and Barharwa (from mile post 144 to mile post 146) in the village of Nalhati, jurisdiction list No. 53, police-station Nalhati. Kuaroratap, district Birbhum, it is hereby declared that piece of land comprising cadastral plots, as detailed below, and measuring, more or less, .08 of an acre, is needed for the aforesaid public purpose at the public expense within the aforesaid village.
