LAND AND LAND REFORMS DEPARTMENT Land Acquisition NOTIFICATION

BIRBHUM—No. 6571-LA Dated 18-10-96
Whereas the functions of the Central Government under the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (Act I of 1894), in relation to the acquisition of land for the purpose of the Union have been entrusted to the State Government by notification No. S.O. 782(E) dated 25th October, 1985 of Rural Development Department issued by Government of India in the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development and published at pages 1 to 3, part II, section 3 of the Gazette of India extraordinary, under clause (1) of article 258 of the Constitution of India.

And whereas it appears to the Governor that land is likely to be needed to be taken by the Central Government at the public expense for a public purpose being a purpose of the Union, namely, for Construction of Pump Station in the Mouza Shibpur, Jurisdiction List No. 102 P. S. Bolpur District Birbhum, it is hereby notified that for the above purpose a piece of land comprising Land Reforms plots as detailed below and measuring, more or less 4.047 hectares (10.00 acres), bounded as specified below is likely to be needed within the aforesaid mouza Shibpur.

This notification is made, under the provision of section 4 of Act I of 1894, to all whom in may concern.

A plan of the land may be inspected in the office of the Special Land Acquisition Officer, Birbhum (Suri).

In exercise of the powers conferred by the aforesaid section, the Governor is pleased to authorise the officers for the time being engaged in the undertaking, with their servants and workman, to enter upon and survey the land and do all other acts required or permitted by that section.

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (4) of section 17 of Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (Act-I of 1894), the Governor is pleased to direct that the Provisions of section 5A of the Act shall not apply to the lands as described in the Schedule below to which in the opinion of the Governor, the provisions of sub-section (1) of section 17 of the said Act are applicable.
