NOTICE

BIRBHUM.—No. 3529-L.A. (II)/58-19/89.—16th May 1989.—Whereas 7.03 acres (2.8449 hectares), more or less, of land situated in or near the village of Lohanagar, jurisdiction list No. 149, police-station Khoyrasole, district Birbhum, described below, have been requisitioned under sub-section (1) of section 3 of the West Bengal Land (Requisition and Acquisition) Act, 1948 (West Bengal Act II of 1948), by the person authorised under the said section 1(A) of the said Act, for the public purpose of creation of better living conditions in urban or rural areas by construction and reconstruction of dwelling places for people residing in such areas or for purposes connected therewith and incidental thereto, namely, for regularisation of Paharpur Squatters' Colony;

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given that in pursuance of section 4 of the said Act, the Governor acquires such land being required for a public purpose as aforesaid.

This notice is given under the provisions of sub-section (1a) of section 4 of the West Bengal Land (Requisition and Acquisition) Act, 1948 (West Bengal Act II of 1948), to all whom it may concern.

A plan of the land may be inspected in the office of the Collector, Birbhum, Special Land Acquisition Department, Suri.
