NOTIFICATIONS

Birbhum.—No. 870L.A.—18th January 1958.—Whereas it appears to the Governor that land is likely to be needed for a public purpose not being a purpose of the Union, namely, for construction of Administrative Buildings and staff quarters of Dubrajpur National Extension Service Block, in the village of Dubrajpur, jurisdiction list No. 137, thana Dubrajpur, pargana Sahalampur, district Birbhum, it is hereby notified that a piece of land comprising part of cadastral survey plot No. 2001 and measuring, more or less, 4.10 acres is likely to be needed for the aforesaid public purpose at the public expense within the aforesaid village of Dubrajpur.

This notification is made under the provisions of section 4 of Act I of 1894, to all whom it may concern.

A plan of the land may be inspected in the office of the Special Land Acquisition Officer, Birbhum.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the aforesaid section, the Governor is pleased to authorise the officers for the time being engaged in the undertaking, with their servants and workmen, to enter upon and survey the land and do all other acts required or permitted by that section.

In exercise of powers conferred by section 17(4) of the Land Acquisition Act I of 1894, as amended by Act XXXVIII of 1923, the Governor is pleased to direct that the provision of section 5A of the Act shall not apply in this case.
