DECLARATION

BIRBHUM No. 58-L.A./21/99-2000/B.K.T.P.P./2000 dated 11th August, 2000,—Whereas the Governor is satisfied that land is needed for a public purpose, not being a purpose of the Union, namely for construction of Resettlement Colony for Bakreswar Dam Evictees for BKTPP in the mouza Tapaspur, Jurisdiction List No. 96, P. S. Sadaipur, District Birbhum, it is hereby declared that a piece of land comprising L. R. plots as detailed below and measuring, more or less, 1.8657 hectares (4.61 acres) bounded as specified below is needed for the above said public purpose at the public expense within the aforesaid mouza.

2. The declaration is made, under the provisions of section 6 of Act I of 1894 to all whom it may concern.

3. A plan of the land may be inspected in the office of the Spl. L. A. O., Birbhum at Suri.
