2003 dated 8th May, 2003—Whereas it appears to
the Governor that land is likely to be needed to be
taken by Government at the public expense for a public
purpose, viz, for construction of Bridge approach,
over river Manikarnika on Bolpur—Rajgram Road
in the mouza Keshabpur, Jurisdiction List No. 9,
P. S. Sainthia, District Birbhum, it is hereby notified
that for the above purpose a piece of land comprising
L.R. Settlement Plots as detailed below and measuring,
more or less, 1.0644 hectares (2.63 acres), bounded as
specified below is likely to be needed within the
aforesaid mouza Keshabpur.

This notification is made, under the provisions of section 4 of Act I of 1894, to all whom it may concern.

A plan of the land may be inspected in the office of the Special Land Acquisition Officer, Birbhum at Suri.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the aforesaid section, the Governor is pleased to authorise the

Officers for the time being engaged in the undertaking, with their servants and workmen, to enter upon and survey the land and do all other acts required or permitted by that section.

Any person interested in the above land, who has any objection to the acquisition thereof, may, within thirty days after the date on which public notice of the substance of this notification is given in the locality, file an objection in writing before the Collector, Birbhum.
