DECLARATION

Birbhum No. 7025-LA/4P-1/96/Power

Dated, the 26th December, 1996

Whereas the Governor is satisfied that land is needed for a public purpose, not being a purpose of the union, namely for construction of Bakreswar Dam in the mouzas Neorghar, Majuria, and Panditpur, Jurisdiction list nos 108, 109 and 111; P.S. - Dubrajpur, District - Birbhum, it is hereby declared that a piece of land comprising Revisional Settlement plots as detailed below and measuring more or less 21.2176 hectares (52.43 acres) bounded as specified below is needed for the above said public purpose at the public expense within the aforesaid mouzas.

The declaration is made, under provision of section 6 of Act I of 1894 to all whom it may concern.

A plan of the land may be inspected in the office of the Spl. L.A. O. Birbhum.
