

**Birbhum.**—No. 6914L.A.(P.W.).—26th April 1963. Whereas 0.20 of an acre, more or less, of land situated in or near the village of Chatmadangal, described below, has been requisitioned under subsection (1) of section 3 of the West Bengal Land (Requisition and Acquisition) Act, 1948, by the person authorised under the said section 3(1) for the purpose of providing facilities for irrigation and drainage, namely, for permanent acquisition of land for water course from chainage 197.78 of Distributary No. 4 of D.B.M.C., in connection with the Mayurakshi Reservoir Project;

Now therefore, notice is hereby given that in pursuance of section 4 of the said Act the Governor acquires such land being required for the public purpose as aforesaid.

This notice is given under the provisions of subsection (1a) of section 4 of the West Bengal Land (Requisition and Acquisition) Act, 1948 (West Bengal Act II of 1948), to all whom it may concern.

A plan of the land may be inspected in the office of the Special Land Acquisition Collector, Birbhum, as well as in the office of the Executive Engineer, Mayurakshi North Canals Division, Rampurhat, Birbhum.
