Whereas .2671 hectare ( 0.66 of an acre), more or less of land  
situated in or near the village of Mirpur, described below has  
been requisitioned under sub-section (1) of section 3 of the  
West Bengal Land (Requisition and Acquisition ) Act, 1948, by the
