

BIRBHUM.—No. 4940L.A./1R-3/64.—19th March 1964.—Whereas the functions of the Central Government under the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (Act I of 1894), in relation to the acquisition of land for the purpose of the Union, have been entrusted to the State Government by notification No. 20/1/55-Judl. (1), dated the 14th May 1955, issued by the Government of India, in the Ministry of Home Affairs, under

of article 258 of the Constitution of India, No. 1074, and published at page 868, Part II, Section 3 of the "Gazette of India", dated the 21st May 1955;

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that land is needed for the public purpose, namely, for the construction of double line on the Sahibganj Loop (Loop Line) between Sainthia and Barharwa (section from 137 mile to 140 mile), in the villages of Ramrampur, jurisdiction list No. 79, Batail, jurisdiction list No. 104, Tilai, jurisdiction list No. 103, Kabilpur, jurisdiction list No. 100, Sadinpur, jurisdiction list No. 95, police-station Rampurhat, pargana Koar Protar, district Birbhum, it is hereby declared that pieces of land comprising cadastral survey plots, as detailed below, and measuring more or less, 2.84 acres, are needed for the aforesaid public purpose at the public expense within the aforesaid villages.
