NOTICE

BIRBHUM—No. 5 L. A. / SPL. / Power dated 16th September, 1994— whereas 0.600 acre (0.2428 hectare), more or less, of land situated in or near the village of Bongaon described below have been requisitioned under sub-section (1) of section 3 of the West Bengal Land (Requisition and Acquisition) Act, 1948, by the person authorised under the said section 3 (1A) for the purpose of providing facilities for transport and communication namely, for diversion of SH-5 Express way passing along Bakreswar Project site.

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given that in pursuance of section 4 of the said Act, the Governor acquires such land being required for a public purpose as aforesaid.

This notice is given under the provisions of sub-section (1a) of section 4 of the West Bengal Land (Requisition and Acquisition) Act, 1948, West Bengal Act II of 1948, to all whom it may concern.

A plan of the land may be inspected in the office of the Collector, Birbhum (Special Land Acquisition Department) Suri.
