BIRBHUM.—No. 1504 (LA(II)/4B-40/80.—11th February 1981.—Whereas .1295 hectare (0.32 of an acre), more or less, of land situated in or near the village of Anandapur described below has been requisitioned under sub-section (1) of section 3 of the West Bengal Land (Requisition and Acquisition) Act, 1948, by the person authorised under section 3(1A) of the Act for the public purpose of maintaining supplies and services essential to the life of the community or for purposes connected therewith and incidental thereto for accommodation of the Settlement Camp Office ;

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given that in pursuance of section 4 of the said Act the Governor acquires such land being required for a public purpose as aforesaid.

This notice is given under the provisions of sub-section (1a) of section 4 of the West Bengal Land (Requisition and Acquisition) Act, 1948 (West Bengal Act II of 1948), to all whom it may concern.
