BIRBHUM— No. 8/P.W (R)/X/ESP 23rd October, 1992— whereas 0.45 acres or 1821 hectares more or less, of land situated in or near the village of Kaijuly described below, have been requisitioned under subsection (1) of section 3 of the West Bengal Land (Requisition and Acquisition) Act, 1948, by the person authorised under the said section 3 (1A) for the purpose of maintaining supplies and services essential to the life of the community for providing facilities for transport/communication, namely for construction of road from Panagar-Dubrajpur-Nalhati-Moregram Road A.
