**NOTICE**

**Birbhum.**—No. 24438L.A.(P.W.).—27th December 1957.—Whereas 0.13 of an acre, more or less, of land situated in or near the village of Haridaspur described below, has been requisitioned under subsection (1) of section 3 of the West Bengal Land (Requisition and Acquisition) Act, 1948, by the person authorised under the said section 3(1) for the purpose of providing facilities for irrigation and drainage, namely, for Brahmani Barrage in connection with Mayurakshi Reservoir Project;

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given that in pursuance of section 4 of the said Act, the Governor acquires such land, being required for a public purpose as aforesaid.

This notice is given under the provisions of subsection (1a) of section 4 of the West Bengal Land (Requisition and Acquisition) Act, 1948 (West Bengal Act II of 1948), to all whom it may concern.

A plan of the land may be inspected in the office of the Special Land Acquisition Officer, Birbhum.
