

BIRBHUM.—No. 5012-1/A (P.W)/11-84/82.—19th April 1982.—Whereas .0708 hectare (.175 acre), more or less, of land situated in or near the village of Haridaspur described below has been requisitioned under section (1) of section 3 of the West Bengal Land (Requisition and Acquisition) Act, 1948, by the petition authorised under section 3 (1A) of the Act for the public purpose of providing facilities for irrigation and drainage, namely, for excavation of a lead channel from ch. 22.00 (Rt) of B.N.M/I;

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given that in pursuance of section 4 of the said Act, the Governor acquires such land being required for a public purpose as aforesaid.
