DECLARATION

BIRBHUM.—No. 9506L.A./1R-8/66. — 31st May 1967.—Whereas the functions of the Central Government under the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (Act I of 1894), in relation to the acquisition of land for the purpose of the Union, have been entrusted to the State Government by notification No. 20/1553Judl. (1), dated the 14th May 1955, issued by the Government of India, in the Ministry of Home Affairs, under clause (I) of article 258 of the Constitution of India, as S.R.O. 1074, and published at page 868, Part II, Section 3, of the "Gazette of India", dated the 21st May 1955;

And whereas the Government is satisfied that land is needed for a public purpose, namely for the construction of a sand siding at Barani Pargana to Farrakka Barrage Project in the village of Fateullapur, jurisdiction list No. 37, (2) Ibika hat, jurisdiction list No. 37, station Murarai, pargana Rajsahi, it is hereby declared that pieces of land comprising cadastral survey plots, as detailed below, and measuring more or less (12.755 acres) (5.1617 hectares) are needed for the aforesaid public purpose at the public expense within the aforesaid villages;
