BIRBHUM.—No. 4068LA(PW)/2R-4/78.—5th April 1978.—Whereas .5261 of a hectare (1.30 acres), more or less, of land situated in or near the village of Bodakuri, described, below, has been requisitioned under sub-section (1) of section 3 of the West Bengal Land (Requisition and Acquisition) Act, 1948, by the person authorised under section 3(1A) of the Act for the public purpose of providing facilities for transport and communication, namely, for the construction of Sahapur-Dubrajpur Road (length 8 K.M. post to 9 K.M. 80M.);

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given that in pursuance of section 4 of the said Act the Governor acquires such land being required for a public purpose as aforesaid.
